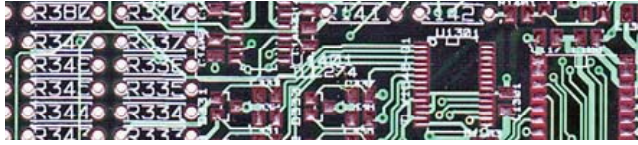


IT Analysis
